On May 5th of 2012 The Quail Motorcycle Gathering will be held in Carmel Valley, California <http://www.quailodgeevents.com/pages/home.cgi?svid=15> It has become the premier motorcycle show in the USA and is held at the Quail Lodge country club in the picturesque Carmel Valley which is about 2-1/2 hours South of San Francisco.

It is very close to the famous seaside resort towns of Carmel and Monterey and 20 minutes from the legendary Laguna Seca Moto GP circuit.

It is a once in a lifetime opportunity to participate in a unique event surrounded by friends who share your passion for Magni motorcycles and the sport of motorcycling. In addition to the event you will be able to take in the sights of San Francisco.
